11 COMES NOW John W. Stone, defendant in the above titled case, is hereby providing formal
12 notice and to demand mandatory judicial notice by this Court, of this, DEFENDANT'S VERIFIED
13 CRIMINAL COMPLAINT ON INFORMATION charging the following named individuals with the
14 criminal violations enumerated infra.

15 Maricopa County officials: Andrew Thomas, Heather Kirka, Sarah Kelly, Matthew
16 McGregor, Judge Peter Swann, Judge Lex Anderson, Judge Michael Orcutt, Constable Ron Meyer,
17 Detectives Graham and Gentry, Rebecca Kirchler, James Haas, and Judge Barbara Spencer.

18 City of Peoria officials: Police Chief David Leonardo, Mayor John Keegan, Detective Thomas
19 Stuart, Officer Michael Griffin, Officer Christopher Cole, Detective Christopher Boughey, Michael
20 Self, and City Attorney Steve Kemp.

21 Other individuals: Kent and Kristina Harding, Scott M. Clark, Paul Henderson, David J.
22 Bodney, Chris Moeser, and Peter Kozinets.

23 To protect the judicial process and the defendant's constitutional rights, this "Notice and
24 complaint" are made to prevent the furtherance of a miscarriage of justice. Unimpeachable evidence
25 proves that the State is retaliating against the defendant and has prevented the defendant from

1 receiving a fair trial by using bad faith and unlawful tactics to gain a conviction. The State's
2 outrageous prosecutorial misconduct is a major shock to the conscious and they are bent on making
3 this Court its accomplice. *STATE V. HUGHES 193 Ariz. 72 74 and STATE V. JORGENSEN, 198 ARIZ. 390, 391*

4 In summary, the defendant hereby formally charges:

5 1. Commission of a misdemeanor committed by willfully subjecting defendant to the deprivation
6 of his fundamental Rights to due process of law equal protection of the law, and to petition the
7 Government for a redress of grievances, under color of laws and statutes in violation of 18
8 U.S.C.A. 242. (one or more counts)

9 2. Commission of a felony by conspiring with one or more of the others charged herein to
10 injure, oppress, threaten or intimidate defendant in the free exercise and full enjoyment of his
11 fundamental Rights to due process of law, equal protection of the law, and to petition the
12 Government for a redress of grievances, and because of his having so exercised the same, in
13 violation of 18 U.S.C. 241. (one or more counts)

14 3. Commission of a felony by corruptly influencing, obstructing or impeding, and by corruptly
15 endeavoring to influence, obstruct or impede, the due administration of justice, in violation of 18
16 U.S.C. 1503. (one or more counts)

17 4. Commission of a felony by knowingly engaging in conduct and thereby wrongfully
18 converting and damaging the tangible property of another person and by threatening to do so,
19 with intent to retaliate against that person for his attendance as a witness and party at an official
20 proceeding, for testimony given and records, documents and other objects produced by a witness
21 in an official proceeding, and for information relating to the commission or possible commission
22 of a Federal offense, in violation of 18 U.S.C. 1513 (on or more counts)

23 5. Commission of a felony by conspiring to engage in a pattern of racketeering activity as a
24 direct result of committing two or more of the predicate acts itemized supra and at 18 U.S.C.
25

1 1961 during the preceding ten calendar years, in violation of Arizona criminal laws and statutes
2 as well as 18 U.S.C. 1962. (one or more counts)

3 6. Commission of a misdemeanor by consenting to collusion and deceit with the intent to
4 deceive a court and party, by failing to support the Constitution and all other laws of the United
5 States and of the State of Arizona, by employing means that are not consistent with the truth, and
6 by seeking to mislead a judge or other judicial officer by an artifice or false statement of fact or
7 law, in violation of Arizona's criminal statutes. (one or more counts)

9 **INCORPORATION OF EVIDENCE**

10 Attached to this Notice is the defendant's VERIFIED CRIMINAL COMPLAINT in which the
11 defendant incorporates by reference, contents of the Clerks' dockets in the instant case, the Federal
12 District Court of Arizona case # CV05-2626-ROS, Avondale City Court case #CV-06-00167, and
13 Peoria Municipal Court case #0710CV2005-04120.

14 **AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE**

15 Defendant now testifies that the evidentiary documents incorporating supra are true and
16 correct, and that they do constitute probable cause formally to charge the above named individuals
17 with the criminal violations enumerated supra.

20 of perjury, under the laws of the United States of America and the State of Arizona, that the statement
